

***Invitation for Manuscripts: Special Edition of the Zoonoses and Public Health Journal***

***Theme: Epidemiology and Control of Foodborne Pathogens in Pork***

The editorial board of the *Zoonoses and Public Health* journal has granted permission for a special issue that we anticipate will be published in middle 2010. The papers presented at the SafePork 2010, Sept. 30 – Oct. 2, 2009, Quebec City, Canada will be considered for potential publication in this *Special Edition*.

***Scope:*** Any research that investigates the foodborne or other pathogens in pork in the following topics: public health, risk assessment, epidemiology and control strategies, molecular epidemiology, detection methods, and antimicrobial resistance presented at SAFEPORK 2010 are eligible for consideration.

***The papers reporting various novel methodologies and approaches or the epidemiology of emerging pathogens will be given special consideration. We encourage all presenters to consider this unique opportunity.***

***Special Edition Rationale***

1. Foodborne and other zoonotic pathogens in pork are important veterinary public health and pig health priorities.
2. Since the first SafePork event in 1996, the scope of the Symposium has expanded beyond *Salmonella* issue to a broader range of foodborne and zoonotic pathogens.
3. The 2009 SafePork Scientific Committee is pleased with the methodological soundness and novelty of the research material submitted for presentation.
4. It is evident that the event will bring together leading international scientists and specialists from various pork-related research fields.
5. Through this initiative the '***SafePork Community***' will share the most recent and prominent research findings with international scientific, policy and industry stakeholders as well as the challenges and opportunities for assuring safe pork and protection of public and pig health in future.
